Program Requirements

Applicants **must** meet the following requirements in order to be admitted to the ACE IT Cosmetology (Hair Design) Program. Students must:

1. be registered at Belmont Secondary School.
2. be fifteen years of age, or older and enrolling in grade 10, 11, or 12.
3. have their parent's/guardian's written permission.
4. demonstrate an interest and a level of maturity suitable for a college level course and a work environment.
5. be able to make provisions for their own transportation to and from work experience job site.
6. attend an information meeting with their parents/guardians.

Documentation to be Submitted with Application

Applicants must:

1. complete a Belmont ACE IT Cosmetology (Hair Design) Program application.
2. have your counsellor complete the 3 Year Education Plan.
3. attach a copy of your most recent secondary school marks.

Interview

Applicants will be required to attend an information session with the teacher. Students will be contacted regarding the date and time of this information session. Individual interviews may take place after the information session.
